Subject: General Services Administration Acquisition Manual;
Technical Correction to GSAM Case 2022-G511, Update GSA Order Citations

1. Purpose. This order transmits a revision to the General Services Administration Acquisition Manual (GSAM) to make technical corrections to the table at GSAM 501.603-1(c)(5)(iv).
2. Background. GSAM Change 157, containing GSAM Case 2022-G511, Update GSA Order Citations was published effective December 7, 2022. The baseline for the case was missing a footnote underneath the table at GSAM 501.603-1(c)(5)(iv) and incorrectly replaced 501.603-1(c)(5)(v) with a note instead of a subparagraph, necessitating a technical correction of the case.
3. Effective date. February 10, 2023
4. Explanation of changes. This amendment includes non-regulatory changes. For full text changes of the amendment see Attachment A, GSAM Text Line-In/Line-Out.

This amendment corrects the following GSAM language:

- 501.6 (General Services Administration Acquisition Regulation System – Career Development, Contracting Authority, and Responsibilities)
 - 501.603-1 (General) – Inserts a footnote underneath the table at GSAM 501.603-1(c)(5)(iv) pertaining to the total lease value of procurements awarded using a Simplified warrant
 - 501.603-1 (General) – Renumbers the “note” underneath table at GSAM 501.603-1(c)(5)(iv) pertaining to GSA’s use of the Government purchase card for micro-purchases, as subparagraph (v)
