GSA ORDER

Subject: General Services Administration Acquisition Manual; GSAR Case 2020-G538, Unique Entity Identification Updates

- Purpose. This order transmits a revision to the General Services
 Administration Acquisition Manual (GSAM) to redesignate the terminology for
 unique identification of entities receiving GSA awards.
- Background. GSA has identified areas of the General Services
 Administration Regulation (GSAR) as well as GSAM with references to
 "DUNS" (Data Universal Numbering System), which need to be updated to
 reflect "UEI" (Unique Entity Identifier) in order to reconcile changes in the
 Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) which made similar changes in 81 FR
 67736.
- 3. Effective date. June 22, 2021.
- 4. <u>Explanation of changes</u>. This order and the amendment contained herein includes both regulatory and non-regulatory changes. For full text changes of the amendment see Appendix A, GSAR/GSAM Text, Line-In/Line-Out.

This amendment revises the regulatory language of the following GSAR suparts, changes summarized below, as follows:

- 504.11 (System for Award Management):
 - 504.1103 (Procedures), changes references to "DUNS" or "DUNS+4" to references to "unique entity identifier".
- 509.4 (Debarment, Suspension, and Ineligibility):
 - 509.406-3 (Procedures), changes references to "DUNS Numbers" to references to "unique entity identifiers".
- 570.7 (Solicitation Provisions and Contract Clauses)
 - 570.701 (FAR provisions and clauses), changes references to "Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS) Number" to references to "Unique Entity Identifier".

This amendment also revises the non-regulatory language of GSAM subparts, changes summarized below, as follows:

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Subpart 504.11—System for Award Management

504.1103 Procedures.

In addition to the requirements found in FAR 4.1103, prior to awarding a contractual instrument the contracting officer must—

- (a) Verify that the prospective contractor's legal business name, Doing-Business-As (DBA) name (if any), physical street address, and -unique entity identifier, as found in the System for Award Management (SAM), match the information that will be included in the contract, order, or agreement resulting from the vendor's quote or proposal. Correct any mismatches by having the vendor amend the information in the SAM and/or the quote or proposal.
- (b) Ensure that the contractor's address code exists in Pegasys and that it is SAM enabled with the contractor's DUNS or DUNS+4 number[unique entity identifier]. This can be done by searching Pegasys records using the contractor's Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN). If no code exists, request that a new address code be established by the Finance Center for SAM compliance.
