42.1305 Contract clauses.

(a) The *contracting officer shall* insert the clause at <u>52.242-14</u>, *Suspension* of Work, in *solicitations* and contracts when a fixed-price *construction* or architect-engineer contract is contemplated.

(b)

- (1) The *contracting officer may*, when *contracting* by negotiation, insert the clause at <u>52.242-15</u>, Stop-Work Order, in *solicitations* and contracts for *supplies*, services, or research and development.
- (2) If a cost-reimbursement contract is contemplated, the *contracting officer shall* use the clause with its AlternateI.
- (c) The *contracting officer shall* insert the clause at <u>52.242-17</u>, Government Delay of Work, in *solicitations* and contracts when a fixed-price contract is contemplated for *supplies* other than commercial or modified-*commercial products*. The clause use is optional when a fixed-price contract is contemplated for services, or for *supplies* that are commercial or modified-*commercial products*.
