50.101-2 Policy.

- (a) The authority conferred by Pub. L. 85-804 may not-
- (1) Be used in a manner that encourages carelessness and laxity on the part of persons engaged in the defense effort; or
- (2) Be relied upon when other adequate legal authority exists within the agency.
- (b) Actions authorized under Pub. L. 85-804 *shall* be accomplished as expeditiously as practicable, consistent with the care, restraint, and exercise of sound judgment appropriate to the use of such extraordinary authority.
- (c) Certain kinds of relief previously available only under Pub. L. 85-804; e.g., rescission or reformation for mutual mistake, are now available under the authority of $\underline{41~U.S.C.~chapter~71}$, Contract Disputes. In accordance with paragraph (a)(2) of this subsection, $\underline{part~33~must}$ be followed in preference to $\underline{subpart~50.1}$ for such relief. In case of doubt as to whether $\underline{part~33}$ applies, the contracting officer should seek legal advice.
