225.771-2 Prohibition.

- (a) The contracting officer shall not award a contract of \$150,000 or more to a firm when a foreign government that is a state sponsor of terrorism owns or controls, either directly or indirectly, a significant interest in—
- (i) The firm;
- (ii) A subsidiary of the firm; or
- (iii) Any other firm that owns or controls the firm.
- (b) For restrictions on subcontracting with a firm, or a subsidiary of a firm, that is identified by the Secretary of Defense as being owned or controlled by the government of a country that is a state sponsor of terrorism, see $\underline{209.405-2}$.
